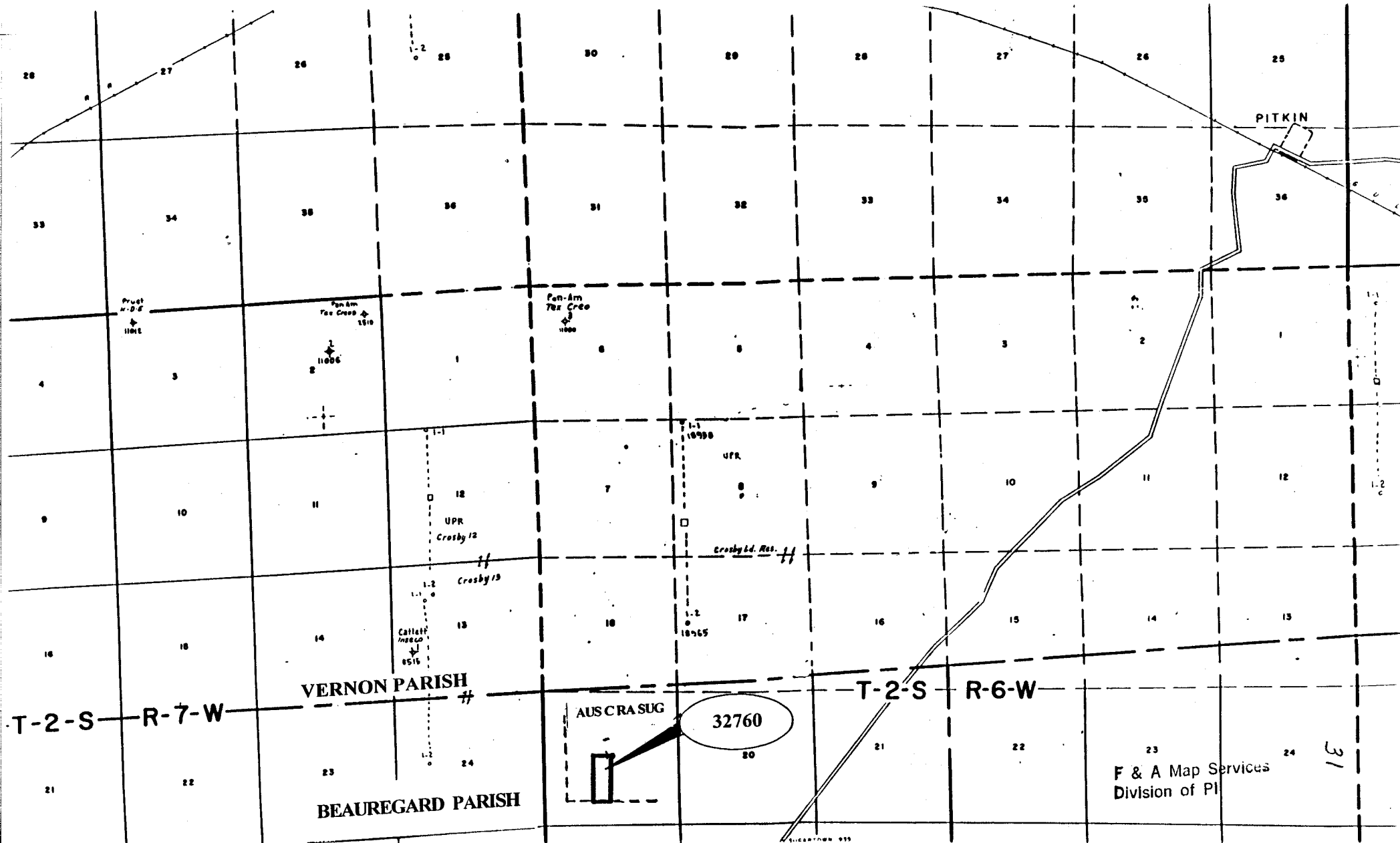


MAP NOT TO SCALE

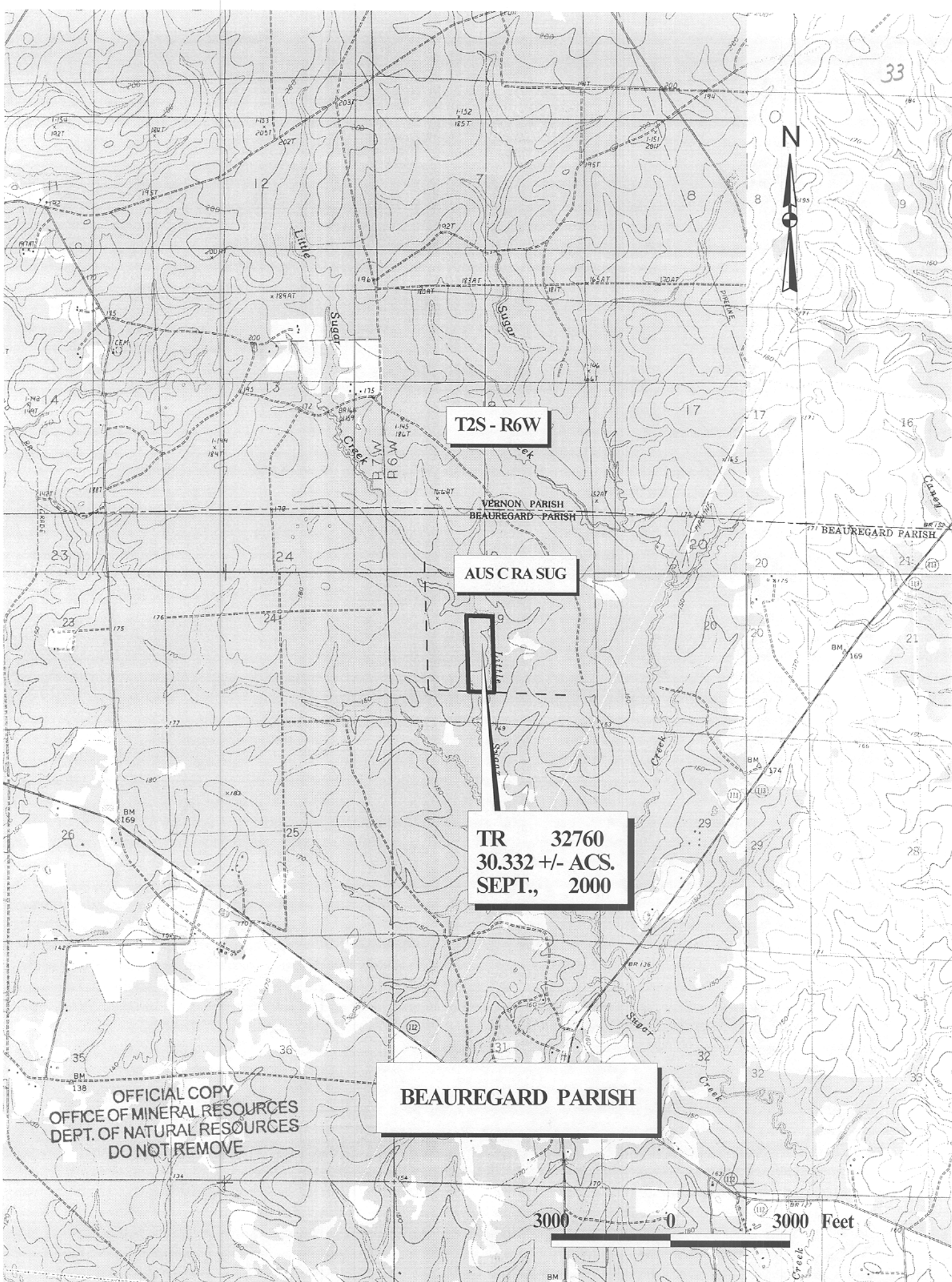
