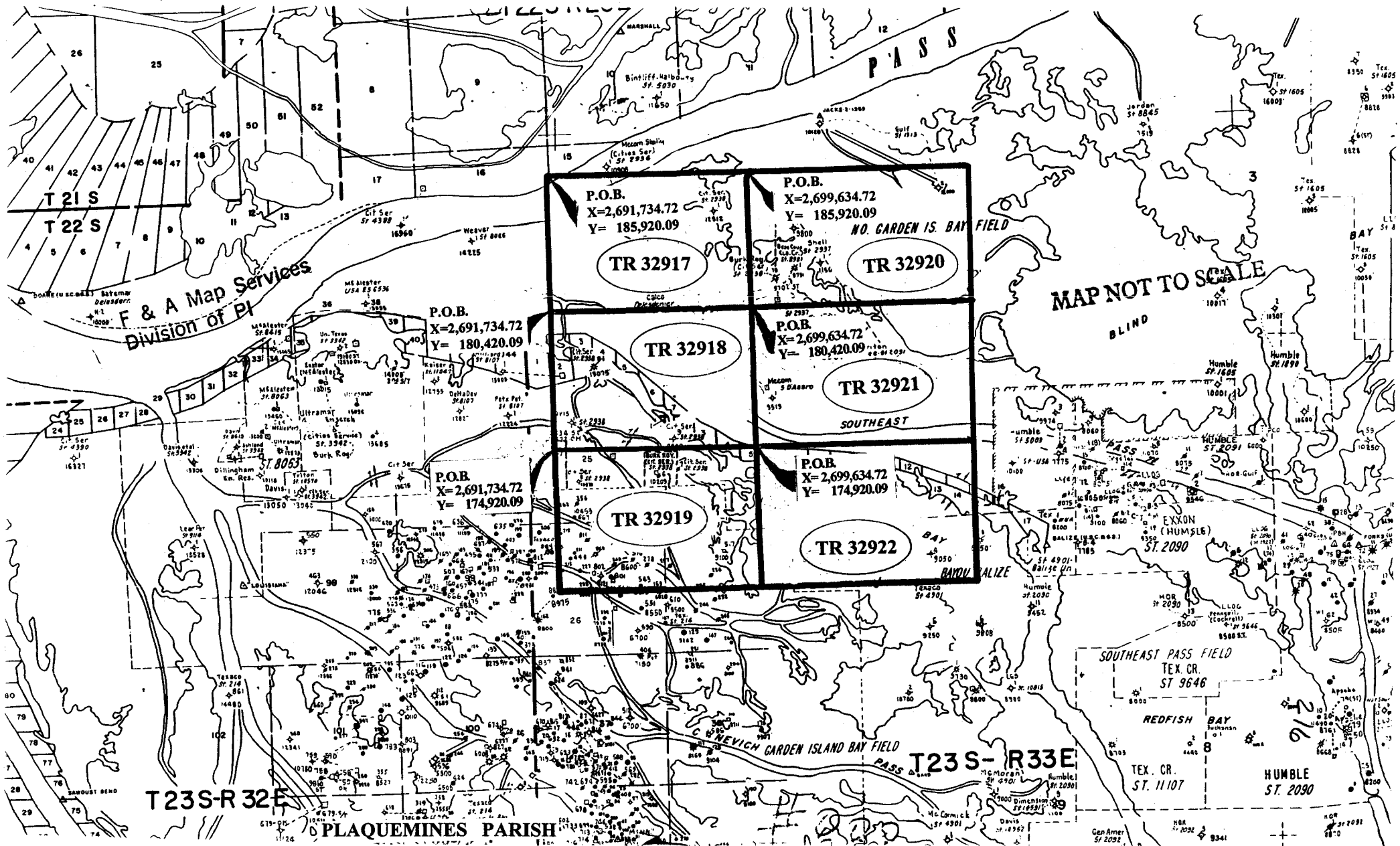

All state owned lands and water bottoms not under mineral lease on November 8, 2000, within the confines of the Pass-A-Loutre Wildlife Management Area as defined by the Department of Wildlife & Fisheries and included in a title opinion from the Office of the Governor, dated August 3, 1998, situated in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, within the following boundaries: Beginning at a point having Coordinates of X = 2,691,734.72 and Y = 185,920.09; thence East 7,900.00 feet to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,699,634.72 and Y = 185,920.09; thence South 5,500.00 feet to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,699,634.72 and Y = 180,420.09; thence West 7,900.00 feet to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,691,734.72 and Y = 180,420.09; thence North 5,500.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing approximately 997.47 gross acres, **LESS AND EXCEPT** 467.93 acres privately owned land, leaving **529.54 net acres**, as shown outlined in red on a plat on file in the Office of Mineral Resources, Department of Natural Resources. All bearings, distances and coordinates are based on Louisiana Coordinate System of 1927 (South Zone).

NOTE: The above tract is located in or near an oyster restricted area and all operations in such area must be conducted in strict conformity with the stipulations and/or regulations of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.

NOTE: 1. No activities will be allowed without written authorization of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.

2. Proposed projects will be evaluated on a case by case basis. Modifications to proposed project features including but not limited to access routes, spoil placement, well sites, flowlines and appurtenant structures may be required by the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.

3. Compliance with the Pass-A-Loutre Wildlife Management Area mineral regulations will be required unless otherwise specified by the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.

4. Compensatory mitigation will be required to offset unavoidable wetland impacts.

5. Removal of all structures, facilities and equipment will be required within 120 days of abandonment unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.

6. No activities will be allowed during the waterfowl season unless authorized by the Department.

7. Prior to submitting applications for wetland permits to Federal and State permitting agencies, the leaseholder shall coordinate project details with the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, Fur and Refuge Division. Contact person for the Department will be Mike Windham at (504) 568-5886.

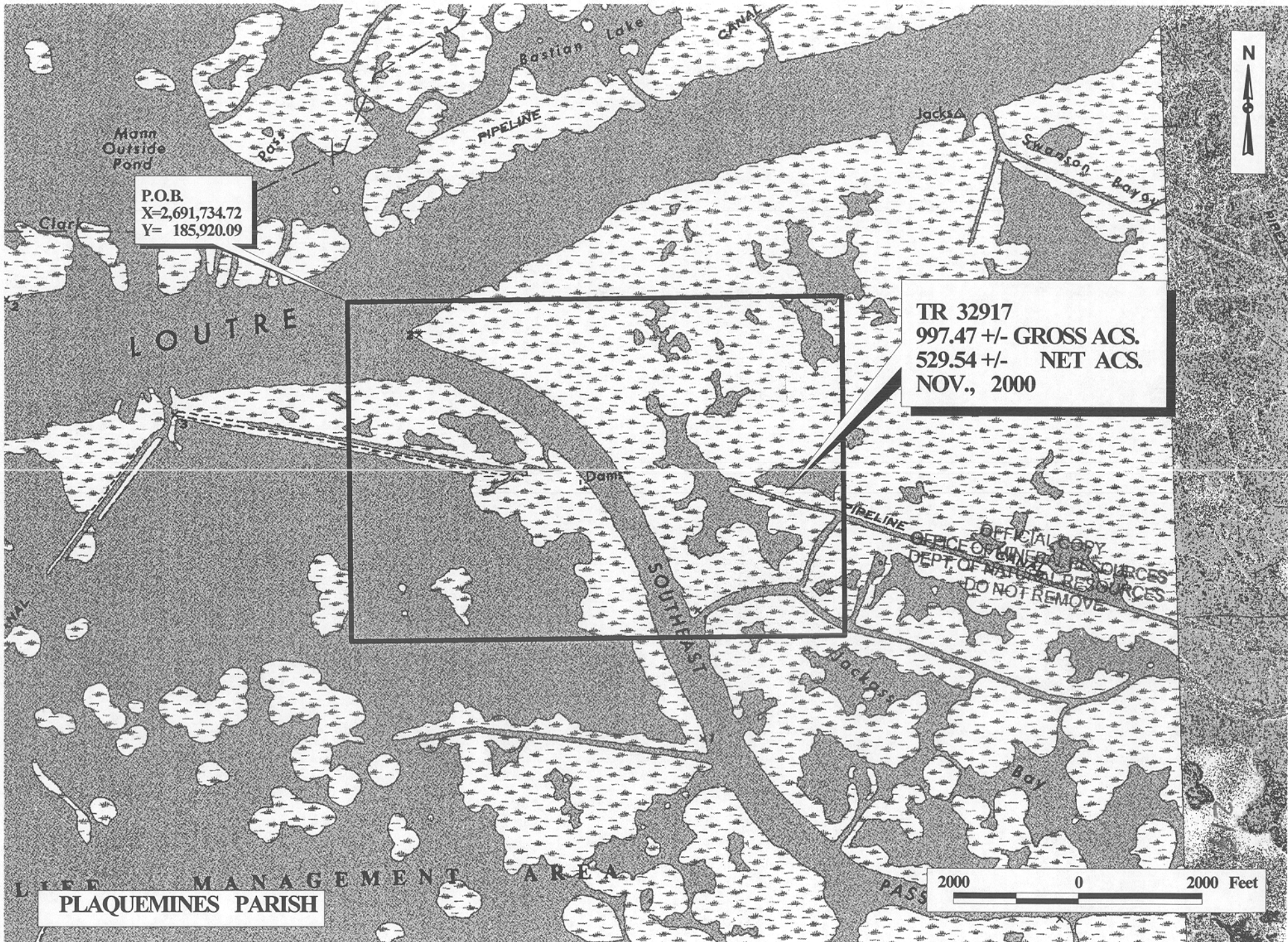
NOTE: The Department will require a minimum bonus of \$350.00 per acre and a minimum royalty of 25%.
