TRACT 32420 - PORTION OF BLOCK 22, MAIN PASS AREA, REVISED, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana

All of the lands now or formerly constituting the beds and bottoms of all water bodies of every nature and description and all islands and other lands formed by accretion or reliction, except tax lands, belonging to the State of Louisiana and not under mineral lease on March 8, 2000, situated in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Block 22, Main Pass Area, Revised, having Coordinates of X = 2,605,850.00 and Y = 337,080.00; thence East 7,375.00 feet on the North line of said Block 22 to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,613,225.00 and Y = 337,080.00; thence South 4,915.78 feet to the Northeast corner of State Lease No. 16430 having Coordinates of X = 2,613,225.00 and Y = 332,164.22; thence on the boundaries of said State Lease No. 16430 the following courses: West 2,400.00 feet, South 45 degrees 59 minutes 32 seconds West 4,727.17 feet and South 6,550.00 feet to a point on the South line of said Block 22 having Coordinates of X = 2,607,425.00 and Y = 322,330.00; thence West 1,575.00 feet on said South line of said Block 22 to its Southwest corner having Coordinates of X = 2,605,850.00 and Y = 322,330.00; thence North 14,750.00 feet along the West line of said Block 22 to the point of beginning, containing approximately 1,316.02 acres, as shown outlined in red on a plat on file in the Office of Mineral Resources, Department of Natural Resources. All bearings, distances and coordinates are based on Louisiana Coordinate System of 1927 (South Zone).

NOTE: The State of Louisiana does hereby reserve, and this lease shall be subject to, the imprescriptible right of surface use in the nature of a servitude in favor of the Department of Natural Resources, including its Offices and Commissions, for the sole purpose of implementing, constructing, servicing and maintaining approved coastal zone management and/or restoration projects. Utilization of any and all rights derived under this lease by the mineral lessee, its agents, successors or assigns, shall not interfere with nor hinder the reasonable surface use by the Department of Natural Resources, its Offices or Commissions, as hereinabove reserved.
