On Wednesday, July 17, 2002 the Office of Mineral Resources on behalf of the State Mineral Board advertised in the Notice of Publication for receipt of sealed bids on or before 12:00 noon on Tuesday, September 10, 2002, for State Leases to be awarded upon Tract Nos. 34806 through 34952, inclusive at its September 11, 2002 Lease Sale. Within said advertisement the description and plat for Tract No. 34952, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana was omitted. By virtue of this public notice, said description and plat for said Tract No. 34952, are hereby included for this sale:

### TRACT 34952 - St. Charles Parish, Louisiana

A certain Tract of land, excluding the beds and bottoms of all navigable waters, belonging to and not presently under mineral lease from St. Charles Parish Government on September 11, 2002, being more fully described as follows: Beginning at a point having Coordinates of X = 2,325,608.40 and Y = 471,671.77; thence East 8,570.69 feet to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,334,179.09 and Y = 471,671.77; thence South 11,120.17 feet to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,334,179.09 and Y = 460,551.60; thence West 8,570.69 feet to a point having Coordinates of X = 2,325,608.40 and Y = 460,551.60; thence North 11,120.17 feet to the point of beginning, containing approximately **28 acres**, all as more particularly outlined on a plat on file in the Office of Mineral Resources, Department of Natural Resources, as provided by the applicant. All distances, bearing and coordinates, if applicable, are based on the Louisiana Coordinate System of 1927, (North or South Zone).
